# **SAINTE-MARGUERITE**

# LA CROISSETTE

# CROIX DES GARDES

 Many locals recharge their batteries on this hill, where no less than 20 km of trails wind through the natural setting, offering pleasant walks, a picnic and wonderful views over the bay. This remarkable hill is much appreciated by the mimosa are in full bloom in February.



# LAGES THE BEACHES

 Adorning its coast from La Croisette to the end of the Boulevard du Midi, via the verdant future Boccacabana, the fine sandy beaches stand united before the Mediterranean. Everyone will find something to please, with beaches awarded the Blue flag, smoke-free beaches and a beach with quality facilities for the disabled.



# LA POINTE CROISSETTE

On the boulevard, keep going until you reach Port Canto, the peaceful Verdun and 8 Mai squares, the luxurious rose garden and Palm Beach, the historic temple to partying, Cannes-style. In the car park stands the small cross, or "crousetto" in Provençal, which most certainly gave its name to "La Croisette".
